1. CHILDCARE

“Jesus said, ‘Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these.’”

Matthew 19:14

Childcare ministries for the youngest members of our community allow us to teach children that they are loved by God. Springwood would partner with qualified early childhood professionals to provide best-practice Christian care and education; and would provide input about curriculum and care through participation on the Board of Directors. The ministry would be self-supporting.



2. COUNSELING

Jesus said, “Come to me all you who are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest.” Matthew 11:28

Life can be hard, but we are not called to bear the burden alone. Christian counselors come alongside individuals, couples, or entire families to journey with them toward healing and wholeness. Springwood would provide affordable counseling space for licensed professionals to provide a variety of therapeutic services. Counselors then pass on the savings to their clients by providing affordable care on a sliding scale.

3. COMMUNITY HUB

Jesus said, “I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty.” John 6:35

How will we offer the living water of Jesus to those who don't come to Sunday worship? Springwood longs to draw folks from around the community into a central gathering place like the well in Biblical times, an intersection where people cross paths through shared interests and purposes.
